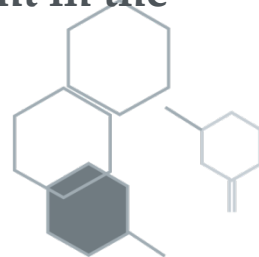

## THE COFUND PROGRAMME

The Marie Skłodowska-Curie (MSC) COFUND scheme aims to stimulate new or existing regional, national or international programmes to foster excellence in researchers' training, mobility and career development, for international, intersectoral and interdisciplinary (3i) research :

- Augment and diversify the set of skills, that will lead to improved employability
- Forge new mind sets and approaches to research and innovation work through interdisciplinary and intersectoral experience
- Enhance networking and communication capacities with scientific peers, as well as with the general public, that will increase and broaden the research and innovation impact
- Increasing the attractiveness of the participating organisation(s), and Europe as destination for research and innovation
- Boosting research and innovation and strengthening of 3i collaborative networks
- Aligning of practices and policies in the context of the HRS4R, improvement in the working conditions, structuring of a stronger ERA
- Supporting the practice of Open Science
- Increase in 3i mobility of researchers in Europe

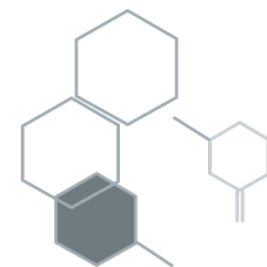

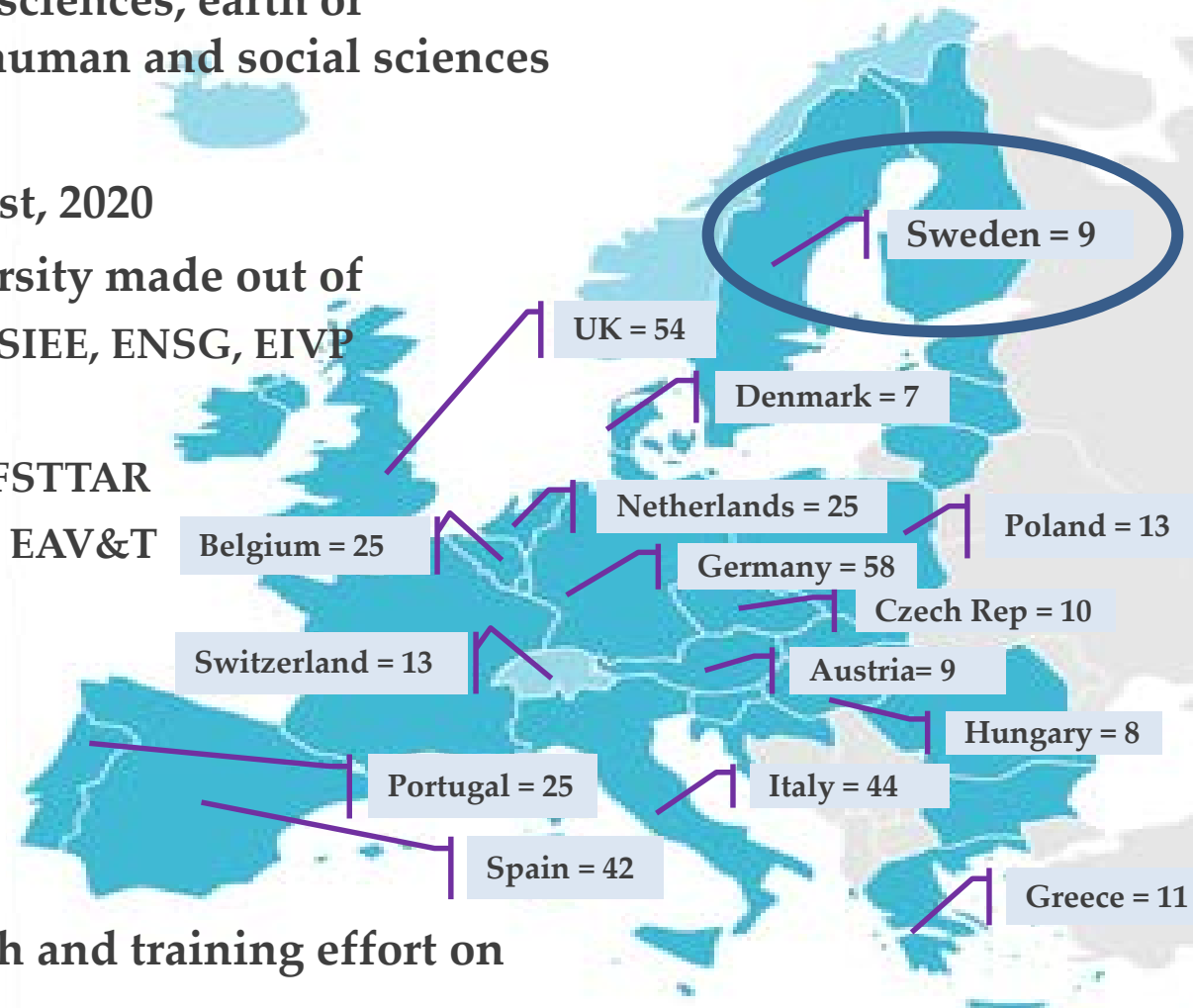
## THE COFUND PROGRAMME

- **Single stage – Deadline Septembre 26, 2019**
- **Ouverture de l'appel 2018 le 12 avril 2018**
- **Deadline le 27 septembre 2018**
- **Succes rate : 32% in 2018**
- **Budget : 35 millions euros for doctoral programme**
- **5 years project**
- **30 pages application file**
- **Funding : around 50% of the overall budget for PhD contracts (+ research, mobility and managements costs)**
  
- **First application (2018) : 64/100**
  - **Excellence : 3,5/5**
  - **Impact : 2,9/5**
  - **Implementation : 2,9/5**
  - **Budget : 4 205 500€ (EU contribution 2 440 800€ = 58%)**



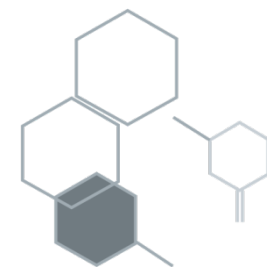
## THE UNIVERSITE GUSTAVE EIFFEL

- Creation on January the 1st, 2020
- Unique pioneering university made out of

  - ✓ A university UPEM
  - ✓ A research institution IFSTTAR
  - ✓ A school of architecture EAV&T
- 17 000 students
- 2 300 staff members
- 500 PhD students
- 25% of the French research and training effort on Cities and transportation



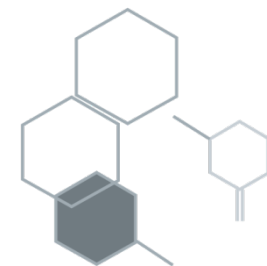
## THE CLEAR DOC PROJECT

- City Lab Education And Research Doctoral programme « CLEAR Doc »
- 3 interdisciplinary aspects of the city of tomorrow :
  - ✓ Designing and developing efficient urban spaces and objects
  - ✓ Understanding and managing the "urban risk"
  - ✓ Developing the digital city and turning it into a catalyst for social, environmental and economic performance
- 2 worldwide calls (2020 and 2021), 30 (15+15) promising early stage researchers around the world in the field of the "City of tomorrow"
- Transparent international selection process with a focus on excellence and 3i aspects (interdisciplinary, intersectorial and international) of the thesis project
- Attractive salary and research package for the PhD student
- Excellent supervision and secondment in other countries and/or non-academic sector
- Best practice for HR and soft skills trainings
